**Invitation to Bid for Repainting of Selected Buildings of
Zamboanga City Medical Center**

1. The *Zamboanga City Medical Center*, through the PHIC-Infrastructure intends to apply the sum of Two Million Three Hundred Thirty Five Thousand Eight Hundred Nine Pesos and Seventy Four Centavos (Php. 2,335,809.74) being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for Repainting of Selected Buildings of Zamboanga City Medical Center Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
2. The *Zamboanga City Medical Center* now invites bids for Repainting of Selected Buildings of Zamboanga City Medical Center.¹ Completion of the Works is required for sixty (60) calendar days. Bidders should have completed a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in **Error! Reference source not found..**
3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act.”

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, cooperatives, and partnerships or organizations with at least seventy five percent (75%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines.
4. Interested bidders may obtain further information from the office of the Bids and Awards Committee and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from 8:00am-5:00pm, Mondays
5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested bidders on September 28, 2017 from the address below and upon payment of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of One Thousand Pesos (Php. 1,000.00).

¹ A brief description of the scope of Works should be provided, including quantities, location of project, and other information necessary to enable potential bidders to decide whether or not to respond to the invitation.

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Procuring Entity, provided that bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.

6. The Zamboanga City Medical Center will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on October 10, 2017, 10:00pm at Cobalt Conference Room, which shall be open to all interested bidders. However, only clarifications from those who purchased the Bidding Documents will be issued a corresponding Supplemental/Bid Bulletin, if meritorious.
7. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat at the address below or at the Cobalt Conference Room on or before October 24, 2017, 10:00am. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in **ITB Clause Error! Reference source not found.**

Bid opening shall be on October 24, 2017, 10:15am at Cobalt Conference Room. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below. **Late bids shall not be accepted.**

8. The *Zamboanga City Medical Center* reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Section 41 of RA 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
